Gil Riviere Campaign Kick Off

Over the last several years, Gil Riviere has volunteered untold hours every week as a key leader on issues ranging from overdevelopment to highway improvements to youth sports and beach access. He has committed himself to countless community service projects and works relentlessly for successful results.

When the City began to ignore limits on the number of surf contests it was allowed to issue, Gil organized Let's Surf Coalition and successfully restored the balance between private events and public beach access.

When traffic jams became a problem at Laniakea, Gil stepped up to advocate for the traffic alternatives study that has been delayed, but should soon begin.

When Kuilima Resort Company re-activated a long dormant and unpopular expansion plan at the Turtle

Bay Resort, Gil became President of Keep the North Shore Country to challenge the decades old environmental study. That case will soon be decided by the Hawaii Supreme Court.

When Waialua Little League was broke and unorganized, Gil stepped in as President and helped re-build the volunteer base and enthusiasm for Hawaii's first Little League, which grew by 25 percent this year over last.

Gil lives and works in Waialua and can be found at almost any time working in our community. He is a strong advocate for the North Shore and our interests. His supporters like to say that "Gil Gets it Done!"
